Protect owner from unnecessary financial risk



Sets mutual expectations, obligations and benefits between owner and crew

4 KEYS TO A GOOD CREW CONTRACT

Duration of Employment: specific start date and end date

Port of Hire: stated home port and responsibility of crewman's travel to and from port Wages and Timing of Payment: stated compensation structure for base and bouse pay

Vessel Specific Standards: duties; drug/alcohol and firearm policies; personal property reimbursement limits

BEST PRACTICES

Give crew time to review the contract

Store all documents securely scan and save digital copies Sign before operations

Get emergency contact info for each crewmember
